WHAT IS THIS PROGRAM?

The Community Powerhouse Family Literacy Project more commonly known as "The Powerhouse" is a program designed to serve African-American males ages 16—24 who have not finished high school, due to drop out, failure to obtain the required units or behavioral issues.

WHAT DO WE STRIVE TO DO?

Ignite and fuel the desire of African-American males to achieve the greatness that is within them.

HOW DO WE DO THIS?

We have empowerment and computer sessions 3 times per week that help improve a participant's reading, employment, life and literacy skills. We also partner with different agencies to assist students with achieving their academic and social goals.

WHERE ARE WE LOCATED?

The program office and sessions are held at 202 S. Gregory St. inside of Faith, Hope & Victory Christian Church.
